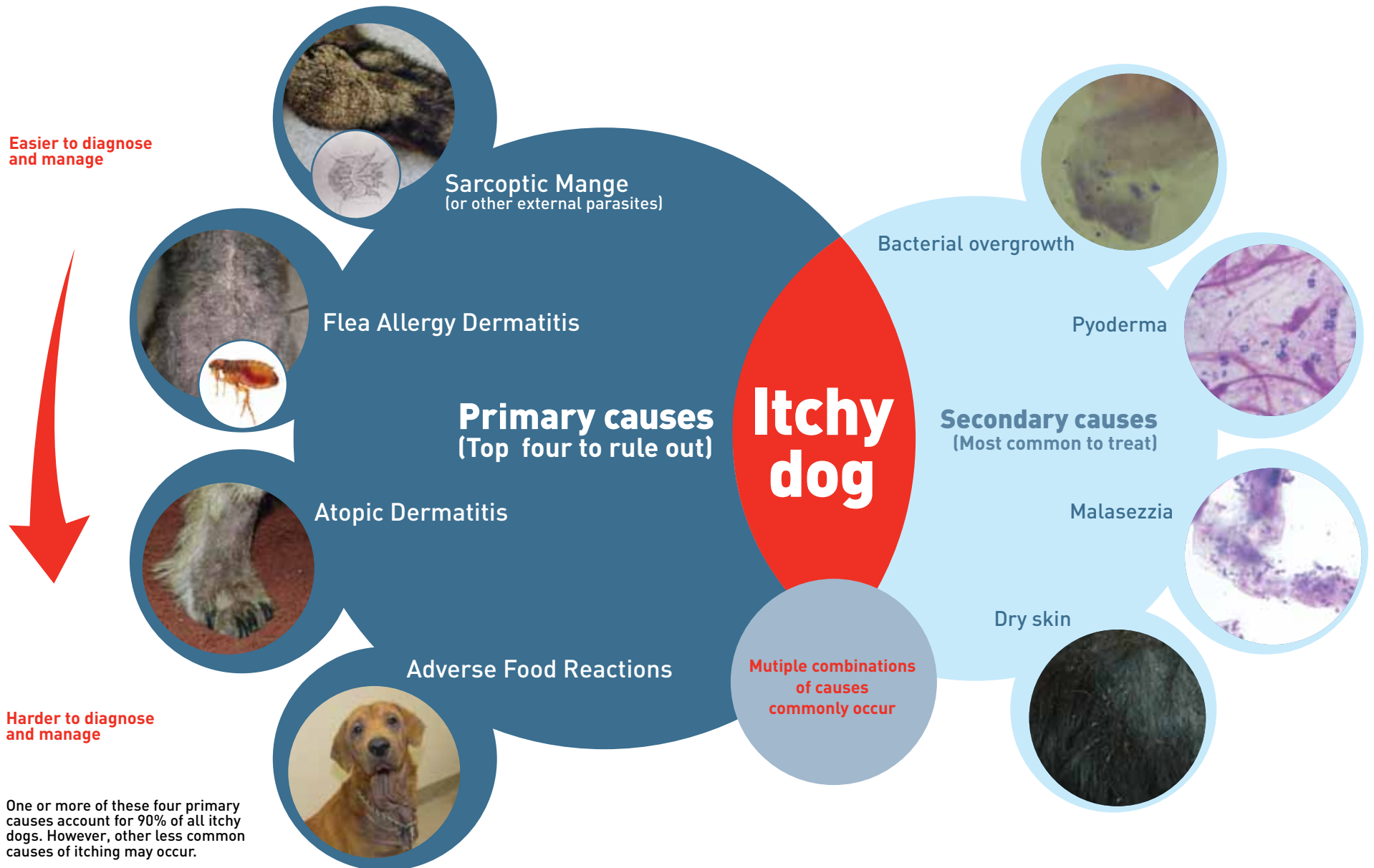

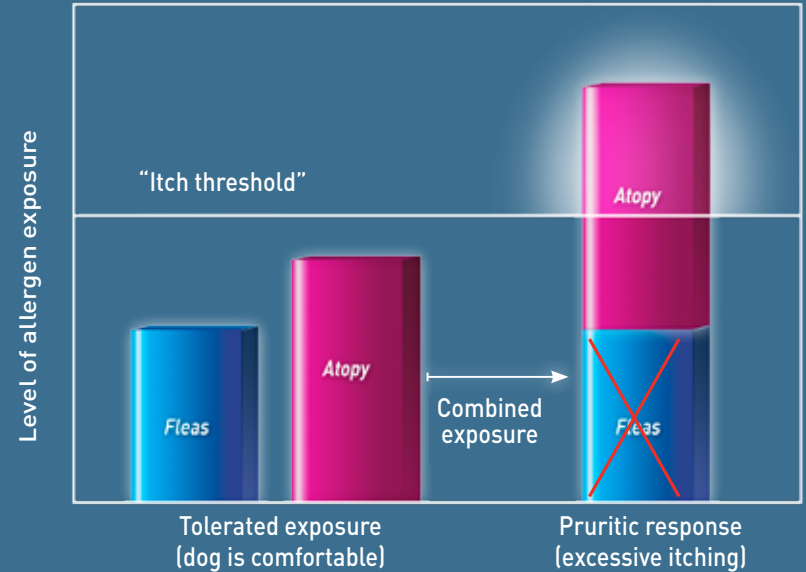
Managing your itchy dog

Goals of today's visit:

- 1) Educate on the causes of itching
- 2) Diagnose and treat secondary cause(s) of itch
- 3) Develop a plan to identify or rule out one or more primary causes of itch
- 4) Develop a plan for long-term control of itch

Due to the additive effects of allergens causing itch, strict seasonal or year-round flea control is necessary in the long-term plan to manage your itchy dog. Compliant use of a veterinary-recommended flea product is required for a positive outcome.
